## Technical Aspects of the Competition

### 1. Number of Participants per category

### 2. Competition Programme

The latest competition programme will be provided 1 week prior to official practice on the World Archery Europe website. Any official competition schedule will have indicated the version number and the date/hour it was printed. Latest version of the Competition Schedule at the moment of writing the Team Managers Booklet is V1.0

### 3. Practice

#### 3.1. Training

Training range will be at Antalya Archery Centre and available from 21<sup>st</sup> of April 2025 as following schedule:

21 – 25 April 2025	09:00 – 11:30 / 14:00 – 17:00
26 April 2025, Morning Session	08:00 – 11:30
26 April 2025, Afternoon Session	14:00 – 16:00 (Only Finalists)
27 April 2025	08:00 – 16:00 (Only Finalists)

#### 3.2. Official Practice

22 April 2025 – 09:00 – 12:00 – RM + CW

22 April 2025 – 14:00 – 17:00 – RW + CM

#### 3.3. Qualification Round Warm Up

3 end of 180 seconds practice on the Field of Play for qualification to immediate follow once the field is reset.

Non-competing athletes can use the practice field, just west side of the Field of Play. Practice range will be equipped by separated timing routines without sound signal.

### 4. Equipment Inspection

- 22 April 2025, Tuesday – The teams will be announced in alphabetical order during the official practice.

- The Equipment Inspection tent will be located east side of the FOP. (Between FOP and Finals Field)
- All teams and Club Archers are to wear their uniform and have their valid Accreditation Card.
- Spare Equipment must also be brought for inspection.
- Team Managers are to check the details of their athletes such as, name, date of birth are correct beforehand.
- Inform the judge if details are not correct and Judge will inform the Results Team for update.
- Instruction to use tablet scoring system will be carried out if requested.

## 5. Athlete (Back) Numbers

Athlete numbers will be issued on the day of qualification round (with the score cards) during the warmup.

Athlete numbers must be worn on the quiver or thigh, facing the waiting line while shooting.

## 6. Qualification Round and Information on Scoring

23 April 2025 – Morning Session: 09:00 – 12:15 – RM + CW

Afternoon Session: 14:00 – 17:15 – RW + CM

4 athletes per target in AB – CD Format

720 Round – 70m / 122cm Face for Recurve and 50m / 80cm Face for Compound.

Electronic score terminals (PDA) for each target will be given by volunteers when athletes will go to target for to collect their arrows.

## 7. Individual Eliminations

Byes are permitted. In case of a bye, athlete might be allowed to shoot on their own target.

No scores will be recorded and displayed and the athletes shooting their byes, must respect to the DOS timing and signals of competition. Recurve athletes are permitted to shoot 3 sets of practice and compound athletes are permitted to shoot 5 ends of practice for their bye.

Target faces will **NOT** be change after practice arrows. Please instruct your athletes to mark all arrow holes during the practice and their byes.

The starting times of sessions and the time schedule for starting to practice will be respected but the matches will continue as soon as the field of play is ready for next round. Proceeding matches will follow up on the immediate completion of prior match.

Individual Elimination rounds will start at the 1/48 elimination stage. (104 athletes in each category or less, depending on entries)

There will be no alternate shooting until semi-final phase for each category.

## 7.1. Recurve Elimination

The Set System will be used for all individual and team matches.

Individual matches will consist of the best of 5 sets, (3 arrow per set) and the winner is the athlete to reach a minimum 6 set points first.

The Team matches will consist of the best of 4 sets (6 arrow per set). The team that reaches minimum of 5 set points first will win the match. All matches, up to including the semi-finals, will be simultaneously on the FOP.

## 7.2. Compound Elimination

Matches for all compound events will use the cumulative scoring, consisting of 5 ends of 3 arrows. All individual matches up to semi-final and all the team matches including semi-final will be shot simultaneously at the FOP.

## 8. Appeal Procedure

In case of Appeal, The Appeal Form should be given to Chairman of Judges or his/her deputy.

To proceed with an appeal, a deposit 50 Euros should be given to the WAE TD or Chairman of Judges for appeal to be valid.

If the Appeal is upheld by Jury of Appeal, the Appeal Fee will be returned. In the case of the Appeal being rejected, the Appeal Fee will not be returned.

## 9. Timing Control System

The local timing control system will be used for timing and score boards.

## 10. Results System

- Qualification Round: Scoring will be completed by athletes. One athlete record on the official paper-based score sheet, the scores of all other athletes on that target. At the same time, another athlete, on the same target, will enter all scores of the athletes on that target into the scoring tablet. The other athletes should verify that all scores are written and entered correctly.
- Scorecards MUST be signed by both athlete and scorer, have all the total mathematically correct with the 10s and 9s count fully completed. Any scorecards where the 10s and 9s count are not completed a “0” will be given for the total of 10s and 9s count for that athlete. Any scorecards not signed or the score total is missing will result in disqualification.
- Elimination Round – scoring will be completed by athletes. One athlete/team records the arrow values of both athletes/teams on the paper score sheet. While at the same time, the other athlete/team inputs the arrow values into the scoring tablet. Both athletes/teams should verify that all scores are written and entered correctly before returning to shooting line.
- At the end of the match, the scorecard must be fully completed and signed by the athletes (or agent/judge in the case of finals) involved in the match.

- Scoring tablets will be used during the Qualification and Elimination Rounds, but not in the Finals.
- **Important Note:** There will be internet access on the field of play and official hotels. Because of this any information and results won't be distributed as printed. All the information's will be published on official web page of WAE ([www.archeryeurope.org](http://www.archeryeurope.org)).

## Logistic Aspects

### 1. Transportation

The shuttle service will be available from official hotels to competition and practice venue. The schedule will be published on hotels and official event page.

### 2. Meals during the event

All meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) will be served at the hotel restaurants according to following schedule:

## Protocol and Ceremonies

### 1. Medal Ceremonies

- Award ceremonies will take place after each gold medal match.
- All the athletes involved in the ceremonies are requested to be ready at the Field of Play during the related gold final match for each division and categories.

## Medical Related Issues (Emergencies)

### 1. Medical Services

- First Aid services will be available during the official training and competition days.
- A doctor and a nurse will be available on site for any emergencies.
- In case of emergencies in official hotels, please inform that contact person in each hotel or Dr. Mehmet Ejder SOZEN (+90 505 535 25 52) who will manage the medical care operations.





## 2. Official Event Hospital

In case of need the Ozel Akdeniz Sifa Konyaalti Tip Merkezi (Kuskavagi, Ataturk Blv. No 81, 07070 Konyaalti / ANTALYA) will be the official hospital for the event.

## 3. Physiotherapy Services

There will be Physiotherapy room on the venue and all teams are invited to use with their own physiotherapist.

## Clean Sport

### 1. Anti-Doping Control

- There will be Anti-Doping control according to Word Ranking Event and World Archery Europe rules.
- Athletes should bring their passports and/or accreditation cards to the anti-doping control station if selected for a test.

### 2. Alcohol Test

Athletes and officials should also be available for random alcohol test during the competition, following World Archery Europe Rules.

## Dress Regulation

- Athletes, officials and staff should wear the appropriate clothing having the correct appearance when on the field during the competition. Open-toed shoes or camouflage clothing, accessories or archery equipment are not permitted.
- Athletes, team officials and technicians should wear their national team uniforms and sport shoes having the same appearance as per the division, following the World Archery Europe Rules.
- We would like to remind all teams that athlete names and country names or codes are mandatory on the back of their national uniform shirts (for club archers only the names are mandatory but may not be worn national team uniform or displayed country names or codes) for athletes participating to World Ranking Events.

## Other Matters of Importance

### 1. Environment

Team Managers, please instruct your team members to use litter bins located on the competition and practice fields.

### 2. Water

The water stations will be located on the competition and practice field entrances. Also, the water fridges will be located in front of the offices which are behind the tents.

### 3. Non-Smoking

- This is non-smoking event.
- Smoking is forbidden inside the public buildings and all competition and training areas including electronic cigarettes.

### 4. Mixed Zone and Press Conference

All the Gold Medal winners will be invited for short interviews just before the award ceremonies.

### 5. Hotel Expenses and Internet Access

- The internet access will be free of charge in the rooms and lobbies at the official hotels.
- All other hotels expenses including laundry and minibar, etc.... will be covered by the participants themselves.
- The internet access will be available at the venue free of charge.
